Winter Eventers Challenge 2018-19

SATURDAY 8.30AM START

Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

SUNDAY 8.30AM START

Class 5 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 6 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 7 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 8 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count

Entry Fee for classes 1 - 8 = £16.00 per rider per round

Paramedic First Aid Cover £4 per rider for the day.

Cheques made payable to The Jays ec Ltd

Entries close 6th November 2018 or earlier if classes are full.

Jumping penalties are awarded as follows....

Knockdown (to include SJ and a few xc fences)	4 penalties
1st Refusal	4 penalties
2nd Refusal	8 penalties
3rd Refusal	Elimination
1st Rider Fall	Elimination
Horse Fall	Compulsory Retirement
Starting before the bell /Retaking an obstacle already jumped/ Error of course	Elimination
Every commenced second over or under the optimum time	1 penalty
Exceeding time limit (3 times the time allowed)	Elimination
Speed 325-375 metres / minute. No stopwatches allowed.	

Body protectors are compulsory. Hair must be above collar length, long hair to be kept in place in a hair net. Crash hats, no fixed peak SJ hats.

The course is made up of SJ & simulated XC fences with an optimum time & no style marks. Riders will jump a series of show jumps and then proceed immediately into the XC phase which is run on an optimum time of 325- 375m/m. Jumping penalties have priority over time faults – so unlike Arena Eventing (JwS) ideally, you need to go clear to win!

In the event of a tie, the competitor closest to the optimum time will be the winner. If teams are tied, the times of the 3 best scores closest to the optimum time will be the winner.

*All classes will be a drawn order - Drawn order and start time will be on the website on **THURSDAY 8th November** from 7pm.

*Entries for individual Sections on the day (if space available) £2.00 extra.

*Competitors representing a school must be in full time education at that school, on the date of competition.

*When mounted, all riders must wear a hat which conforms to Pony Club/BSJA rules.

*The decision of the judge is final.

*The organisers have the right to cancel, amend, or add to classes.

*Objections to be made to the secretary in writing within 20 minutes of dispute, with a deposit of £10.00.
