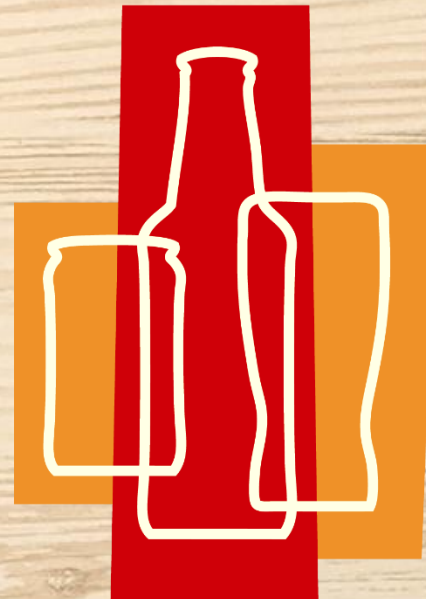

## About the Asia Beer Championship

### Asia's Awards

Now in its fifth year, the annual Asia Beer Championship was launched to support the rapidly developing beer culture that has taken hold in the region and provides a trusted quality benchmark for consumers as well as independent feedback to the regions' brewers.

The primary focus of the competition is to help the region's brewers develop their brewing skill and production processes to enable them to maximize the opportunities of the growing demand for craft beer in the marketplace.

The Asia Beer Championship is open for entry to any beer brewed commercially within Asia and beers may be entered into any of the 32 different styles categories selected for the competition (28 beer & 4 cider).

### 2022

The Asia Beer Championship 2022 will be judged in Singapore on the 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> September 2022 with a live awards presentation to be hosted at this year's SEA Brew Brewers Conference & Trade Fair in Bangkok on 28<sup>th</sup> October.

### Judging

An international panel of expert judges will assess the competition beers & ciders in a blind tasting and award Gold, Silver & Bronze certificates to the top 3 beers in each category respectively. Beers that score over 38 points (out of 50) but do not win a medal will receive a Chairman's Selection certification.

### The Organizers

The Asia Beer Championship is organized by the Asia Brewers Network (ABN) - a news and resource portal for the region's brewers. The ABN was established to help build the regional brewing community through in-person and online events. The ABN is run by the team behind the highly successful "SEA Brew" regional brewers conference and trade fair (est. 2015).



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## Who Can Enter?

Any brewery that is brewing their beers in Asia for commercial sale/distribution may enter. Please see the full list of countries in Rules & Regulations (Page 7).

## Competition Categories

Beers are grouped into **32** beer/cider Style Categories – 28 for beer, 4 for cider

Brewers should enter their beer in the appropriate Category, selecting the beerstyle sub-category for their particular entry.

**Example:** A brewer entering an International Pale Lager style beer would enter their beer as: Category 4 International Lager, Sub-Category 2A International Pale Lager

The Sub-categories follow the Beer Judge Certification Programme (BJCP) Style Guidelines

## Competition Categories

In addition to Gold, Silver, Bronze and Chairman's Selection awards presented to the best beers in each category, there will be the following Trophies awarded:

Champion Beer of Asia  
Champion Large Sized Brewery of Asia      Champion Medium Sized Brewery of Asia  
Champion Small Sized Brewery of Asia      Champion Brewpub of Asia

Champion Wheat Beer of Asia, Champion Lager of Asia, Champion Pilsner of Asia, Champion Pale Ale of Asia, Champion IPA of Asia & Champion Cider of Asia

## How to Enter

- 1) Go to our **ONLINE REGISTRATION** page:

- 2) Complete your registration
- 3) Make payment for your registration. You will be directed to make payment through online payment portal PayPal, you can either use your existing PayPal account or pay as a 'guest' with a credit card.
- 4) Prepare your judging samples: **4 x 330ml bottles/cans per entry**
- 5) Send your beers to arrive at our collection facility in Singapore (address on Page 8) between 19<sup>th</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup> September.

## Competition Timeline

- July 4th** Competition Registration Opens
- August 31st** Competition Registration Closes
- September 19th – 23rd** Competition beers arrive in Singapore (*beers will be kept in cold storage until judging takes place*)
- October 6th & 7th** Competition Judging in Singapore
- October 28th** Results Announcement (*at SEA Brew 2022 in Bangkok*)

## Rules & Regulations

**1. Judging.** Beers will be judged 'blind' by our panel of international experts (professional brewers and certified beer judges). Judges will be presented each competing beer in its appropriate category flight in a clear cup for evaluation according to the following 50 points Beer Judge Certification Programme judging criteria:

- **Appearance:** Max 3 pts
- **Mouthfeel/Body:** Max 5 pts
- **Aroma:** Max 12 pts
- **Overall Impression/Technical Quality:** Max 10 pts (Total 50 pts)
- **Flavour:** Max 20 pts

The points allocated will be used as judging guidelines only, beers will advance in the competition and Gold, Silver, Bronze and Chairman's Selection will be awarded through judges discussion and consensus.

Judging notes will be returned to brewers for all beers entered into the competition.

**2. Style Guidelines.** Beers will be judged in category according to their corresponding BJCP Style Guidelines\*. Brewers should enter the Category and Sub Category they wish to have their beer judged by in their entry form. Please see full Competition Categories above or online at:

The competition organizers and judges reserve the right to disqualify beers they deem to have been entered into the incorrect category. **Brewers should include tasting notes with their Entry Form if the judges need guidance for beer assessing.**

**3. Definitions.** For the purpose of the Asia Beer Championship 2022, an Asian Brewery is defined as a brewery of any size producing beer for commercial purposes (sale on site or for national/regional distribution) in the following countries:

Afghanistan, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bahrain, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Brunei, Cambodia, China, Dubai, Georgia, India, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Japan, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kuwait, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Lebanon, Malaysia, Maldives, Mongolia, Myanmar (Burma), Nepal, North Korea, Oman, Pakistan, Palestine, Philippines, Qatar, Singapore, South Korea, Sri Lanka, Syria, Taiwan, Tajikistan, Thailand, Timor-Leste, Turkey, Turkmenistan, United Arab Emirates, Uzbekistan, Vietnam, Yemen.

Beers brewed at rented brewing facilities, "**Gypsy/Contract Brew Beers**", may also enter the competition so long as the facilities used for production are located within one of the above countries.

A "**Brewpub**" is considered a restaurant or pub that has an on-site brewery with at least 70% of its produced beer volume sold on the premises.

**4. Awards.** The top 3 beers in each category will be awarded Gold, Silver & Bronze certificates respectively, any beers scoring 38 points or over will be given a "Chairman's Selection" accolade. In the event of a tie the Chairman's decision is final. The top beer in each style category will enter a taste-off for the "Champion Beer of Asia" award. Award winning and "Chairman's Selection" beers will be given digital versions of their award category logo (Gold, Silver or Bronze) for their own marketing and promotional use. The results of the competition will be publicly announced at an Awards Presentation Ceremony at SEA Brew 2022 in Bangkok on the 28<sup>th</sup> October at the Berkeley Hotel Pratunam.



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## Rules & Regulations (cont.)

**5. Champion Breweries Category.** Breweries who enter 4 beers or more will qualify automatically for the Champion Brewery of Asia award in their size class. The brewery with the best 4 scoring beers will be awarded Champion Brewery of Asia in their class; Champion Small Brewery of Asia, Champion Medium Brewery of Asia & Champion Large Brewery of Asia respectively. Brewery classes are based on the size of their main brew vessel/kettle as outlined below:

- Small Sized Brewery: Brew vessel 1 – 9 HL
  - Medium Sized Brewery: Brew vessel Size 10 – 29 HL
  - Large Sized Brewery: Brew vessel size 30 HL and over
- \*HL = Hectolitre (100 litres)*

**6. Champion Brewpub of Asia.** This trophy will be awarded to the Brewpub with the 4 highest ranking beers in the competition. A brewpub is considered a restaurant or pub that has an on-site brewery with at least 70% of its produced beer volume sold on the premises.

**7. Samples & Labelling.** Brewers should submit **4 x 330ml bottle/can samples per entry**. Beer samples may be submitted for judging with either their commercial labels on/in their commercial packaging or in blank bottles labelled with the appropriate information. Labels should contain the following information:

- Name of Brewery
- Name of Beer
- Alcohol by Volume (ABV)
- Country of Origin
- Ingredients

Any brewers notes for judges reference should be submitted on your Entry Forms at the time of registration.

**8. Shipping Instructions.** Please arrange for your judging samples to arrive in Singapore between **19th – 23rd September**. Samples should be shipped to the below address (our collection point in Singapore):
