

Web presence: security and GDPR summary

Where is my data stored?

The Web presence service is provided from an industry standard and certified data center located in the European Union, in Dublin, Ireland.

What do I need to know about Web presence and GDPR?

While using the Web presence service, similarly to any other service nowadays, you will be asked to give a minimal information (e.g.: name, email address) in order to allow us to provide your service.

The information you provide is stored in an ISO 27001 certified data center within the European Union.

The data you provide is only retained until you are using the Web presence service.

Is the Web presence data center certified?

Yes. The Web presence service's information security policy is based on ISO 27001 standard and covers these standard security requirements.

What are the security measures take to protect my personal data?

To ensure that your data is protected while you are using the Web presence service, a large number of security measures are in place.

These are categorised into network security, system security, data security, application security and physical security measures.

Some of the examples contain access control list filtering, DDoS protection and dual-encryption processes. For the physical protection of the data center there are card and biometric screeners, full time security personnel and limited employee access in place.
