ON THE DAY: Team Managers will be required to declare their team on arrival, and no later than 30 minutes before the start of the class, using the official Declaration Forms supplied by BRC HQ. Each horse will be checked against the Flu Vaccination Certificate brought with the competitor. Any horse with a certificate found to be incorrect will not be allowed to enter H.C. and counts as disqualification, so they may not be replaced in their team, either at the qualifier or at the finals, should the team qualify. Hat and tack inspection will be in-hand

As a rule of entrance, each Area 21 Riding Club who wishes to enter must supply:

1 Helper per Team or 1 Helper per 3 Individuals

The job role will be allocated by TVRC and posted along with the times.

Please make sure your helpers are comfortable with the job role.

These may include arena party work or stewarding etc, if you have a preference please include on your Area Entry Form

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition.

All entrants must pay a prelim entry to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Entries can be made via the prelim website and are **£9.50 / Individual & £35 / Team**. Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual (payable to BRC HQ), if there are sufficient spaces. **Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.**

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry. **Prelim entries that cannot attend the new date may be issued a credit note but the Team Manager must inform the office in writing before the new qualifier date.**

Hats

All hats must have a visible aqua BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

Body Protectors

A body protector is obligatory in all cross-country competitions. Please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document. which can be found at the link below for further information regarding this: <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-rulebook>

Riders wearing Exo Body Cage protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

Medical armbands

Medical armbands are mandatory. These must be worn on the arm and not on the leg. They should be filled in with the relevant competitor's details. Checks will be carried out in the collecting ring.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

Numbers to qualify as per Appendix 10 dependant on Appendix 9 in the current BRC Handbook.
