**Class 3 Grass Roots Qualifier Teams and Individuals – Fences 60cm.
Single Phase. (For the NSEA East of England Grass Roots Regional Final)**

**Class 4 Grass Roots Qualifier Individual – Fences 70cm.
Single Phase. (For the NSEA East of England Grass Roots Regional Final)**

Entry fee £16 per round per rider per round
Plus £4 per rider – first aid
