Please note that Preliminary entries on the official forms must be at BRC HQ, Stoneleigh by **21st September 2018**

Only full members who have been declared to BRC HQ by this date are eligible to compete in the qualifying competition.

Area entries must be on official forms downloaded from www.britishridingclubs.org.uk

All entrants must pay a prelim entry of £29 per team to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days Before the date of the qualifier (above). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries www.britishridingclubs.org.uk or online entries can be made via the BHS bookshop www.britishhorse.com. Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team, if there are sufficient spaces.

ON THE DAY: Team Managers will be required to declare their team on arrival, and **not later than 30 minutes before the start of the class**, using the official Declaration Forms supplied by BRC HQ.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

All hats must have a visible orange BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.
